8.2 Matters arising - Action Taken Report

Item	Discussion/Resolution
8.2.1	With regards to the submission of charge out rates for Engineering Professionals to the government, the meeting was informed that the submission had been made to the Ministry of Housing & Infrastructure Development for approval.
8.2.2	With regards to accessing the Benevolent fund to include the disabled, the meeting was informed that access to the fund was non-selective and a total of K100,000 had been paid out the previous year.
8.2.3	The meeting resolved to take punitive action against members engaged in professional misconduct, the meeting was informed that this was a continuous process and that there were currently 28 active cases before the Disciplinary Committee.
8.2.4	A concern was raised as to why the Institution had decided to sell some shares to Engineering Companies to which the meeting was advised that it had not been approved by the EIZ Properties Board or Engineering Council.
8.2.5	With regards to the International Engineering Alliance, it was suggested that Secretariat takes a more proactive role by holding as many sensitisation sessions as possible to explain the process to the members.
